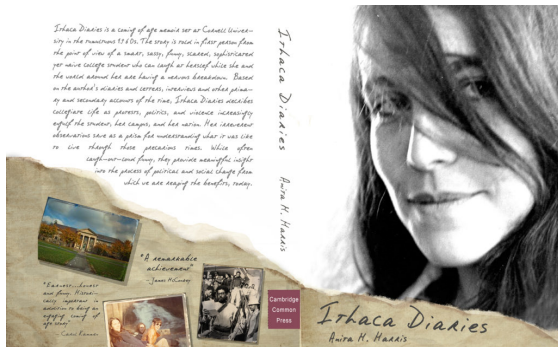


Millennials Support Ithaca Diaries Kickstarter Campaign
